West Carteret Water Corporation is a member-owned, B-Well water treatment utility located in western Carteret County, NC adjacent to Bogue Sound. We currently have a full-time and a part-time immediate opening for experienced NC Licensed B-Well Operators. We will accept A-Well Operator applicants, in addition to, C-Well Operator applicants. The latter must have the ability and willingness to successfully pass the B-Well Operators exam within one year.

The following details are provided to assist you in the application process:

- System Details:
 - Plant location 4104 Highway 24, Newport, NC 28570 (Adjacent to Administrative Office)
 - Plant/Wells:
 - 2.7 mgd plant manned 24 hours per day; Nonpeak usage 1.1 mgd to peak 1.9 mgd. Process includes raw water aeration, iron removal, Ion exchange (color/softening), corrosion inhibitor, chloramine disinfection using chlorine gas and LAS (10 months). Backwash lagoons with discharge permit requirements.
 - Eight (8) deep wells with one entry point.
 - Gravity system with elevated storage that includes two 750,000-gallon tanks and one 600,000-gallon tank.
 - Distribution: 189 miles of distribution along the Highway 24 Corridor, including major side roads, communities, and towns (Bogue, Cape Carteret, Cedar Point, and Peletier); Approximately 8,000 active connections plus large, bulk sales customers.
- Preferred Experience/Other:
 - Two (2) years experience for individual or combined certificate levels.
 - o Computer experience a must; Custom Wonderware SCADA System.
 - Physical Chemical Certification or interest in obtaining a plus, but not necessary.
 - o Distribution Licenses not necessary, but will positively impact wage.
- Current Schedule:
 - Three shifts rotate weekly: 8 a.m. 4 p.m., 4 p.m. midnight, midnight 8 a.m. Includes weekends and holidays, unless on approved vacation. (Example: 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. Sunday must return midnight. However, upon 5-day completion of midnight shift at 8 a.m. on Friday, next shift begins 4 p.m. the following Wednesday.)
 - Holidays recognized on actual date and currently paid double time for time worked in addition holiday pay. For example, Christmas Day/8-hour shift would

be calculated as 8 hours holiday pay plus 8 hours X = 24 hours paid for 8-hour shift.

- Pay Scale (based on previous years and practical experience):
 - C-Well: \$35,838.40 \$52,686.40; \$17.23/hr \$25.33/hr
 - B-Well: \$38,833.60 \$57,324.80; \$18.67/hr \$27.56/hr
- Other/Benefits:
 - 90-day probationary period for benefits/180-days for final performance review.
 - Retirement: 401k-5% matching.
 - Insurances available after 90-day probationary period:
 - Major Medical Zero cost BCBS; \$0/100% coverage (HSA deposit made to offset deductible; prorated based on employment period as compared to coverage period of August-July. Twelve months receives full \$3,000 deductible in HSA.)
 - Principle Mutual Dental
 - Blue 20/20 Vision
 - \$50,000 Life.
 - AFLAC available as payroll deduction.
 - Family coverages available with payroll deduction.
 - Uniforms Yearly shoe allowance; Pants, shirts, coats, and safety gear provided.
 - 8 hours annual and 8 sick leave accrue monthly after 90-day probationary period; Conversion to PTO expected in 2024.
